Introduction

Bodies Covered by the NAR

1. This document includes details of the assets of the main department and details of assets held by the following bodies:
 - a) the department's executive Agencies - NHS Pensions Agency, NHS Estates Agency, Medical Devices Agency and the Medicines Control Agency (a Trading Fund);
 - b) its executive Non Departmental Public Bodies (NDPBs);
 - c) Health Authorities;
 - d) Special Health Authorities;
 - e) NHS Trusts; and
 - f) the Dental Practice Board.

Using the data on the NAR

NHS

2. The NHS has operated a system of full capital charging for a period of 5 years. This has meant that all decisions on purchase and delivery of services have had to take account of the full cost of the use of capital. Inevitably this has influenced those decisions in favour of those most effective in their use of capital and encouraged disposal of expensive or under utilised assets.

Main Department

3. Work on the National Asset Register is complementary to that being undertaken for Resource Accounting and Budgeting. In particular, the work done to prepare for the first trial year of departmental resource accounting has helped to build up a picture of the main department's fixed asset base. This in turn has facilitated the compilation of the NAR. The details gathered will help to estimate the impact of the introduction of capital charging under resource budgeting.

Relationships between bodies covered by the NAR

Executive Agencies

4. Executive Agencies are self-contained units which carry out specific executive functions on behalf of the department within an operational framework agreed by Ministers. The Medical Devices, NHS Estates and NHS Pensions Agencies provide services to the NHS and to the Department of Health. The Medicines Control Agency is primarily a licensing body which has little business with other bodies covered by the NAR (apart from the Department of Health).

Executive Non Departmental Public Bodies

5. The Department's executive Non Departmental Public Bodies are statutory bodies which, although sponsored by the Department, operate at arm's length from Government. They were set up to undertake specialist tasks and they receive funding from both the public and private sectors. The majority do little business with other bodies covered by the NAR. The exception is the Public Health Laboratory Service; approximately half of the activity of this body involves providing services to the mainstream NHS.

Health Authorities

6. Health Authorities, along with GP Fundholders, are responsible for securing a range of hospital and community health services for their resident populations (mainly from NHS Trusts). Due to the nature of their role - they are largely administrative organisations - they do not have the sort of high value operational assets held by NHS Trusts.

Special Health Authorities

7. Special Health Authorities have been set up separately from the mainstream NHS to carry out specialist tasks. The functions of SHAs are not necessarily restricted to the NHS in England and some have UK wide responsibilities. Some receive the majority of their funding from the Department of Health, some from the private sector, whereas others are integrally part of the providing side of the NHS.

NHS Trusts

8. NHS Trusts are responsible for providing a range of hospital and community health services under contract to health authorities and GP Fundholders.

Dental Practice Board

9. The Dental Practice Board is an NHS body and its role is to check and price remuneration claims from dentists in the General Dental Services; to authorise and make dental contract payments; maintain the registration of patients and monitor dentists' activities for quality and probity.

Levels of aggregation

10. Levels of aggregation have been chosen so as to balance the requirement to provide complete and useful information with the need to keep this document to manageable proportions. As a result, more descriptive information is given about the department's own assets than for the NHS, where - for simplicity - assets are aggregated at the level of particular bodies (e.g. NHS Trusts).

Table 1: Departmental Asset Register

11. Table 1 includes details of assets held by particular areas of the Department and its Agencies. The table also covers the Central Council for Education and Training in Social Work (which is an Executive Non Departmental Public Body) and the Health Education Authority (which is a special health authority). Neither of these bodies published audited accruals accounts for the financial year 1997-98 and so their assets could not be included in Tables 2 or 3a respectively alongside those of other NDPBs and SHAs.

12. No investments or intangible fixed assets have been disclosed in this table as none are held by the areas of the department listed.

13. Where freehold property exists, details have been given of the floor area and the use to which the building is put. The main items within the asset class 'Plant, equipment and Computers' are normal office furniture and office IT networks. Any significant installations within particular buildings eg specialist equipment such as health fitness suites are separately identified within 'Fixtures and Fittings'.

Table 2: Information on other non-NHS Bodies

14. This table contains details of assets held by all the Department's Executive Non Departmental Public Bodies (NDPBs) except for the Central Council for Education and Training in Social Work.

15. The assets of NDPBs belong to them and in most cases sponsoring departments have only limited powers over a body's decisions on whether to purchase or dispose of assets. Most major executive NDPBs already publish audited accounts which contain some information on their fixed assets, including valuations. Given the arm's length relationship that these bodies have with the Department, their assets have been aggregated at the level of each body.

16. Table 2 provides asset values for each body, extracted from their published annual accounts for the year ended 31 March 1997. Values are at current prices. These accounts are prepared along commercial accounting lines although specific accounting policies adopted may vary from body to body eg the capitalisation threshold.

17. Readers of this document can find more information on the detailed fixed asset accounting policies of each of the NDPBs listed in the body's own published accounts. These are available from The Majesty's Stationery Office.

Table 3a: Information on NHS bodies - Health Authorities

18. The statements in paragraph 15 above are also relevant here.

19. Asset values in this table have been extracted from the locally audited accounts of the Health Authorities and Special Health Authorities as at 31 March 1997. These figures have yet to be audited by the National Audit Office. Values are at current prices. Accounting policies are based on standard accounting practice for the NHS approved by the Secretary of State and accounts directions issued by HM Treasury. Asset classes listed in the table are consistent with these directions. These classes are different from those used in Table 2.

20. In some cases, assets are donated to Health Authorities (eg. by charitable trusts), and these items have been included within Health Authorities' figures. In other cases, charitable trusts hold assets on their own account and these are not included in the Health Authorities' figures.

21. All assets falling into the following categories are capitalised:
- i tangible assets which are capable of being used for more than one year, and have a cost equal to or greater than £5,000;
 - ii groups of tangible assets which are interdependent or would normally be provided or replaced as a group with a total value in excess of £5,000 and an individual value of £250 or more; and
 - iii At Health Authority discretion, a collection of assets which individually may be valued at less than £5000 but which form part of the initial equipping and setting up cost of a new building.
22. Further information on the detailed fixed asset accounting policies can be found in the accounts of individual Health Authorities, which are published locally.

23. The statements in paragraph 15 above are also relevant here.
24. In some cases, assets are donated to NHS Trusts (eg. by charitable trusts), and these items have been included within Trusts' figures. In other cases, charitable trusts hold assets on their own account and these have been excluded from the Trusts' figures.
25. Asset values in this table have been extracted from the locally audited accounts of the NHS Trusts as at 31 March 1997. These figures have yet to be audited by the National Audit Office. Values are at current prices. Accounting policies are based on standard accounting practice for the NHS approved by the Secretary of State and accounts directions issued by HM Treasury. Asset classes listed in the table are consistent with these directions. Further information on the detailed fixed asset accounting policies can be found in the accounts of individual NHS Trusts, which are published locally.
26. To increase the usefulness of this document to its readers, in addition to the financial information on assets held by each NHS Trust, details of the service profile (ie the main activities) and the average daily availability of beds in each NHS Trust are also provided.

Table 3c: NHS assets held by the Department of Health

27. Most of the NHS assets held by the core department are those where ownership did not pass to the NHS Trusts when they were formed. These assets are owned by the Secretary of State for Health and are managed by the Regional Offices of the Department of Health. Accounting policies applied to these assets are as for other NHS assets. Values of assets are at current prices as at 31 March 1997 and have been extracted from asset registers held by Regional Offices.

28. Further information about each of the bodies within each of the categories listed above can be found in their annual reports and accounts which are published and made available locally.

Table I: Departmental Asset Register

Land & Buildings

Freehold land & buildings

- Wellington House, located in Waterloo Road, London, is a building of about 11400m² which is used for administrative purposes.
- Richmond House, located in Whitehall, London, is a building of about 10700m² which is used for administrative purposes.
- 6-12 Capital Drive, Milton Keynes, is a building of about 2500m² which is used for administrative purposes.
- John Snow House, located in Durham, is a building of about 2200m² which is used for administrative purposes.
- The Wheelchair Evaluation Centre, located in Blackpool is a site on which there are a number of buildings covering an area of about 300m². The buildings are used for administrative and testing purposes.
- Glenthorne Youth Treatment Centre, located in Birmingham, is a specialised secure residential facility of about 7000m² used for the accommodation of children under Sections 25 and 53 of the Children and Young Persons Act.
- St Charles Centre in Brentwood, Essex is a site covering an area of about 7 hectares. The site is not currently in use and is awaiting disposal.

Leasehold buildings

- Various leasehold buildings are held including those used for administrative purposes by Regional Offices, and a building in Stanmore used by the British Pharmacopoeia Laboratory for the assessment of chemical substances. Some leasehold buildings (eg. Skipton House, London) have been significantly refurbished or enhanced to enable them to be used for the Department's administrative purposes.

Plant, Equipment and Computers

- Office furniture used in all Department and Agency buildings.
- An office IT network covering the core Department, NHS Pensions Agency, Medical Devices Agency, and NHS Estates Agency.
- An office IT network used by the Medicines Control Agency.
- An office IT network of the Health Education Authority.
- 3 video conferencing suites in Departmental buildings.
- Specialist laboratory equipment at the British Pharmacopoeia Laboratory.

Fixtures and Fittings

- Specialist catering equipment installed in staff restaurants.
- Health/Fitness suites in various buildings.
- Carpeting in all buildings.
- Specialist security and lighting installations at the Glenthorne Youth Treatment Centre.
