



Al-Qaida and Taliban

This notification is issued in respect of the financial measures taken against Al-Qaida and the Taliban.

Her Majesty's Treasury issues this notification to advise that on 3 December 2009 the United Nations Sanctions Committee removed one individual from the UN Consolidated List maintained under Resolution 1390 (2002). The individual therefore no longer falls within the UK financial sanctions regime under the Al-Qaida and Taliban (United Nations Measures) Order 2006.

The removal made by the UN Sanctions Committee is set out in the Annex to this notification and the Consolidated List of Financial Sanctions Targets which is maintained on the Treasury website has been updated to reflect the removal.
