



General Notice of Revocation of Article 4 Direction

Terrorism (United Nations Measures) Order 2001 (S.I. 2001/3365)

Where a condition set out in article 4(1) of the Terrorism (United Nations Measures) Order 2001 (SI 2001/3365) ("the Order") is satisfied, Her Majesty's Treasury have power to direct that a person is designated for the purposes of the Order.

On 26 August 2003 the Treasury through the Bank of England acting as its agent by notice gave a direction (the "Direction") under article 4(1) of the Order designating the entity set out in the Annex to this Notice for the purposes of the Order.

The Treasury has revoked the Direction. The entity is therefore no longer a designated person for the purposes of the Order and is no longer subject to financial sanctions imposed by the Treasury.

The entity has been removed from the Consolidated List of Financial Sanctions Targets which is maintained on the Treasury website.
