



## General Notice of Article 4 Direction

30/07/2010

### Terrorism (United Nations Measures) Order 2009

This Notice is issued in respect of the financial measures taken against terrorism.

It should be noted that this Notice does not result in any change to the Consolidated List of Financial Sanctions Targets maintained on the Treasury's website.

1. On 19 April 2002 the Treasury gave a direction ('the Direction') under article 4(1) of the Terrorism (United Nations Measures) Order 2001 designating for the purposes of that Order the individual set out in the Annex to this Notice. The Direction was varied in respect of the individual on 21 May 2002.
2. This Notice is to publicise generally the Treasury's revocation of the Direction, as varied, insofar as it relates to the individual set out in the Annex to this Notice with effect from 29 July 2010 and the giving of a new direction ("the 2009 Order Direction") under article 4 of the Terrorism (United Nations Measures) Order 2009 ("the 2009 Order") designating the individual for purposes of that Order ("the designated person"). An effect of the 2009 Order Direction is that the funds and economic resources of the designated person must be frozen.

#### Prohibitions

3. By virtue of the 2009 Order Direction, which has effect until further notice, the prohibitions in articles 10 to 14 of the 2009 Order apply in respect of the designated person.
  - Article 10 prohibits any dealing with funds or economic resources owned held or controlled by a restricted person.
  - Articles 11 and 13 prohibit the making available of funds, financial services or economic resources, directly or indirectly, to a restricted person.
  - Articles 12 and 14 prohibit the making available of funds, financial services or economic resources to any person for the benefit of a restricted person.

"Restricted person" means:

- (a) a designated person;
- (b) a person owned or controlled, directly or indirectly, by a designated person; or
- (c) a person acting on behalf of or at the direction of a designated person.

## Reporting requirements

4. Relevant institutions and other persons are requested to check whether they maintain any accounts or otherwise hold any funds or economic resources for, or provide financial services to, the designated person and, if so, they must freeze such accounts or other funds and, unless licensed by the Treasury, refrain from dealing with or making available such funds and/or economic resources and suspend the provision of any financial services. Relevant institutions must report their findings to the Treasury.

Where a relevant institution has already reported details of accounts, other funds or economic resources held frozen for the designated person, they are not required to report these details again.

## Licences

5. The Treasury have power to license certain transactions, payments and dealings which would otherwise breach the prohibitions in articles 10 to 14 of the 2009 Order. Any person who wishes to apply to the Treasury for a licence should apply in writing to the Asset Freezing Unit at the address provided in paragraph 7 below. The application should clearly set out the grounds on which the licence is sought and provide full details and evidence (e.g. utility bills) in support.

## Challenging a Direction

6. A designated person or any other person affected by the 2009 Order Direction who wishes to challenge the 2009 Order Direction or any other decision made by the Treasury under the 2009 Order in respect of the 2009 Order Direction may under section 63(2) of the Counter Terrorism Act 2008 apply to the High Court or, in Scotland, the Court of Session, to have the 2009 Order Direction or other decision set aside.
