



### **Terrorism (United Nations Measures) Order 2006 Al-Qaida and Taliban (United Nations Measures) Order 2006**

This Notice is issued further to the Notice issued yesterday regarding the Supreme Court judgment in the case of HM Treasury v Ahmed and Others which concerned the UK's implementation of United Nations obligations to freeze the assets of terrorists and those associated with Al-Qaida and the Taliban by way of two Orders in Council made under section 1 of the United Nations Act 1946 ('the UN Act'):

The Supreme Court has today decided to consider further the Treasury's request to stay the judgment for a period and will make an order in due course. Therefore both the Terrorism (United Nations Measures) Order 2006 and the Al-Qaida and Taliban (United Nations Measures) Order 2006 remain in force pending the Court's decision.
